Thankyou for all the parents' support during the autumn term!

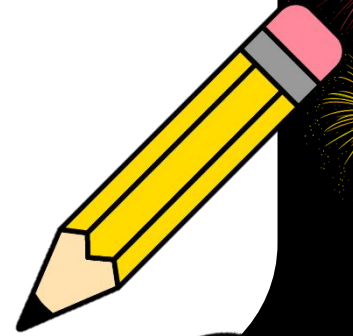

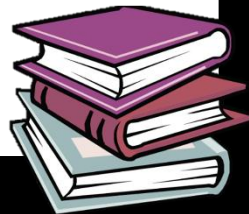

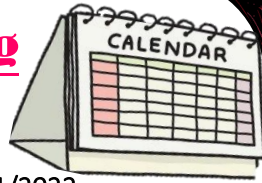

PCR tests for Under 5's:

As you are aware the guidance regards isolating in the case of positive Covid outcomes is everchanging. The latest guidance has been updated to include children under 5. The government has confirmed that children under five who live in the same household as someone who has tested positive for Covid must take a PCR test. Therefore, based upon this update if you have a positive case in your household please inform us and keep your child at home until they receive a negative PCR test. We appreciate your support with this.

A few reminders:

-Primary School applications:

the deadline for applying for a primary school place is 15th January 2022, please apply on time and don't be late at:

-Labelling

Please ensure that all your children's' items of clothing (including shoes, hats, scarves and gloves) are all clearly labelled.

-Clothing

Please dress your child in clothes that are easy for them to manage as we encourage the children to access the toilet independently. Also bringing a spare change of clothes, diapers, pull-ups and baby wipes (if not toilet trained). It would also be very helpful if you could help your child with learning how to put their coat on and off.



-Packed Lunches

Please ensure that your child's lunch is in a clearly labelled lunch box. Please note: no nuts, and no fizzy drinks or squash.

Please remember to add some fresh fruit or vegetables to our child's lunch box.

-Picking Up/Dropping Off

Please whilst either picking up or dropping off your child please stay away from the blue gate due to the Covid Restrictions.
